
# <u>V4 – EaP contacts at the bilateral level</u> <u>CONCLUSIONS</u>




## V4 is unable to speak with one voice with Russia on any major issue, and no one wants to modify it






# It is hard to find any humanitarian or pro-democratic accents in the V4 policies towards Russia





## The V4 governments change, but the policy towards Russia remains unchanged






# The very first commandment of each V4 country's eastern policy is not to alienate Russia




